Memo to all Document Checkers re CRB forms for those working with adults:

In the light of uncertainty at national level we have decided to clarify what we expect as a diocese at the moment.

Future changes may occur when the government completes its review of the Vetting and Barring scheme.

- We would like all those involved in home visits to elderly and/or vulnerable people for the purpose of pastoral visiting / taking communion etc to have a CRB check.
- All those who visit parishioners in a care home should ask the home whether they require a CRB check.
- Those who help at general church activities which some vulnerable adults may attend do not need a CRB check.
- Those who help at activities which are specifically aimed at vulnerable adults do need a CRB check.
