

# Leading Intercessions

## how to lead the prayers of intercession in worship

- For:** Those leading, or intending to lead, the intercessions in church services
- Sessions:** One session
- Duration:** Two hours
- Cost:** Nominal/Donations
- Trainers:** members of the Diocesan Worship and Liturgy Committee

This training event can be run for a parish or group of parishes, and put on at a venue within those parishes. The training can be tailored to specific needs or requirements, from beginner to advanced, from formal to more creative ... Samples, guidance notes, and resources lists will be given out, and opportunity given to write your own prayers and share them.

The training session can include any or all of the following: \* Voices: speaking up and using a microphone \* What are intercessions? \* How do they fit into the service? \* What should we pray about? \* How should we pray? \* Using the official prayer books \* Using other printed or downloaded material \* Composing your own prayers (pertinent to the occasion, congregation, age group, circumstance) \* Special occasions (e.g. healing services, remembrance ...) \* Using silence \* Using music \* Using visual aids (inc. OHPs, projectors) \* Using other items (candles, water, movement, prayer stations ...) \* Congregational involvement \* Sharing in praying (use of drama, different voices)
