a wasp

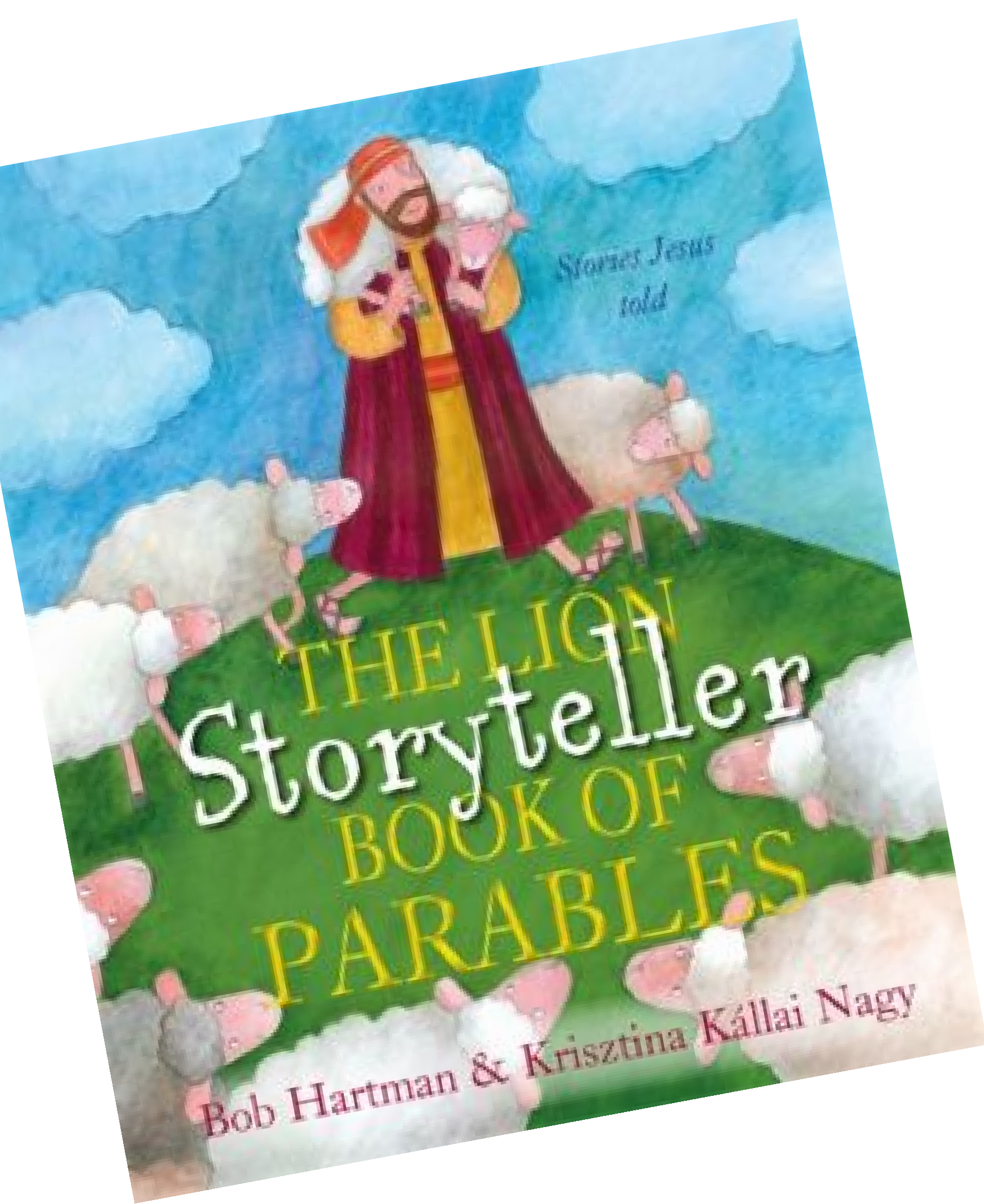
a paper cut

stubbing your little toe




Read the Parable about A little bit of Yeast.
