Did you know that growing grapes to make wine is very complicated?

#### Growers have to think about

- the soil
- the sunlight
- the rainfall
- the wind direction
- how to support the vines as they grow
- the pests that might spoil the plants
- when to harvest the grapes

...the list goes on!



Vines need to be cared for to grow and flourish. They need something to cling to and climb up that provides safety and shelter.

This is often called a trellis.

If the vine didn't have the trellis, it would be all floppy on the ground and would get eaten by bugs.


It wouldn't grow and flourish!



Jesus said, 'I am the vine and you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will bear much fruit; for you can do nothing without me. I love you just as the Father loves me; remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love.'

What do you think Jesus means?

Jesus is saying the best way to flourish is to 'remain or **rest** in his love. He provides safety and shelter just like the trellis provides for the vine so it can grow well.





**Jesus said,** 'Come to me, all of you who are tired from carrying heavy loads, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke and put it on you, and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in spirit; and you will find rest.'
