We will be quiet whilst we look at it. Then we can share what we are thinking about.






The potter creates amazing things with their hands.

### Do you know someone who is really creative?

Louis Braille was a creative person.

He was born over 200 years ago. But when he was just three years old he had a terrible accident and lost his sight. He was blind.

Louis wanted to read and tried to learn by running his fingers over raised letters but it was very hard. So he invented a special system of writing using coded dots embossed on card so he could feel the bumps and read! Amazing creativity!



The Bible says the Earth is a gift - carefully created by a Creator God! God is creating and re-creating all the time.

#### Psalm 24 in the Bible says:

The world and all that is in it belong to the Lord; the earth and all who live on it are his.

He built it on the deep waters beneath the earth and laid its foundations in the ocean depths.
