Children and Young People

We have well established links with local schools, with children coming to St Mary's for visits and services. We have a lovely children's corner, with lots of toys and books to explore. With our partner church All Saints, we run an annual Holiday Bible Club, and we have a youth group, for those of secondary school age, called 'Generations' that meets every month for discussion, activities and fun.

Choir and Organ

St Mary's has an enthusiastic adult choir of about 16. We rehearse every Friday evening and sing every Sunday, either at Holy Communion or at Evensong. We're a very friendly bunch, with an extremely wide range of ages and backgrounds, but united by our love of singing. St Mary's organ was recently restored and improved, and can now do amazing things, such as automated concerts with lightshows.



Community

The area of Fishponds is a very diverse one, with a bustling high street full of coffee shops and restaurants contrasting with areas of poverty. Many people pass through our wonderful tree filled churchyard, and we are actively pursuing new ways to welcome them into our church family.
